
# Cultural Heritage Induction booklet Licenced Tour Operators Summerday Valley

Gariwerd - Grampians Parks and Reserves



November 2019





#### Background

Heritage listed for its biodiversity and significant cultural heritage, the Grampians National Park was established in 1984 to protect environmental and cultural values of national importance. The park has more than 800 indigenous plant species and is home to one third of Victoria's flora, a range of wildlife, and the majority of surviving Aboriginal rock art places in south-east Australia.

Key legislation that drives Parks Victoria's management of the Grampians National Park and its management of these values includes but is no limited to the Parks Victoria Act 1998, National Parks Act 1975, Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999 (Cth) and Aboriginal Heritage Act 2006 (Vic).

In June 2019, Parks Victoria announced that existing Licenced Tour Operators (LTOs) offering rock climbing and abseiling at Summerday Valley (which is within a Special Protection Area) in the Grampians National Park had been issued a variation to their existing licences. The variation provides strictly conditional authorisation for LTOs to continue undertaking rock climbing and abseiling activities in three designated areas within Summerday Valley (Barc Cliff, Back Wall, and a section of Wall of Fools). The licences have since been extended and are currently valid until 31st March 2020.

#### **Traditional Owners**

The inductions will be delivered by the Barengi Gadjin Land Council Aboriginal Corporation (BGLC) with support from Parks Victoria.

#### Induction

BGLC will deliver 4 Cultural Induction sessions for existing LTOs in November 2019 at Summerday Valley. These sessions will be facilitated by Traditional Owners, and are expected to take approximately 1 hour to deliver. The session will include:


- Welcome to Country by Traditional Owners;
- Safety briefing;
- Introduction by all and answer the question what Cultural Heritage means to you?;
- Parks Victoria "Aboriginal Heritage induction guide" 2017 handed out, talk to all values within the booklet;
- Walk to Wall of Falls and show Quarry site and birds eye view of Artefact Scatter;
- Traditional Owners can talk to the area and conduct their induction (at Wall of Falls);
- Discussion on impacts from climbing and visitors (at Wall of Falls);
- Walk around to all climbing sites and show the go and no-go zones; and
- Allow time for general or open questions.

Cultural Induction sessions will be conducted at no expense to the Licenced Tour Operators.


#### **Conditions**

Parks Victoria and the Traditional Owner groups established have several conditions and processes that LTO's must adhere to and/ or be aware of these include, but are not limited to:

- It will be compulsory, once the induction program has been agreed upon, for all LTOs who
  wish to undertake rock-climbing or abseiling activities within Summerday Valley to complete
  an Aboriginal cultural heritage induction program;
- The only locations included in the Cultural Heritage permit will be 3 walls/cliffs (Back Wall, a section of Wall of Fools and Barc Cliff). Please refer to attached maps/ photos;
- All tour guides and their customers must be clearly identifiable when on site (signage);
- Areas available to rock climbing and abseiling within Summerday Valley will be monitored for environmental and cultural values;
- Parks Victoria and Traditional Owners will undertake compliance activities in Summerday Valley;
- Tour guides must be clearly identifiable when on site (signage);
- A booking system will be applied to Summerday Valley. LTOs are required to access this to register their activities;
- Continued access to Summerday Valley beyond the 31<sup>st</sup> March 2020 will be subject to LTOS meeting these and other conditions; and
- LTO access to Summerday Valley for rock climbing or abseiling activities can be suspended by Parks Victoria in consultation with Traditional Owners at any time.
